Rules, Procedures, and Information

1. All Band and Individual Piping entries must be postmarked by **May 5, 2010**. We apologize however we cannot accept field entries.
2. Mail entry form, **stamped self-addressed envelope (SASE)**, and a check made out to "Glasgow Highland Games" to:

Band entries do not require an SASE.
3. Saturday admission passes will be mailed prior to the competition.

4. All competitors, except for Grade V solo & Novice Tenor, must wear suitable Highland attire to compete and accept prizes.
5. Draw for order of play for band contests will be held 2 weeks prior to the contest. Bands will be notified not later than 1 week prior to the contest.
6. A travel allowance for bands will be paid based on mileage (\$300 over 300 miles; \$150 all other bands). To receive the travel allowance, bands must compete and participate in all massed band events on Saturday
7. These games are EUSPBA sanctioned and EUSPBA rules will apply. **NOTE: The March Set for Grade 4 and Grade 5 bands shall be defined as six to eight parts of march music, simple time, no time limit.** See <http://www.euspba.org/resource/rule/rulesregs.pdf> for 2010 revised tune requirements.
8. If you have not yet received your Pipe Band Association member number, please annotate "Pending" on the EUSPBA (or other Assoc#) line. We verify member #'s directly with the associations.
9. The Glasgow Highland Games reserves the right to cancel any event for which insufficient entries are received.
10. The number of entries accepted may be limited due to time constraints. Entries will be accepted in order post-marked: first post-marked, last to play. Entries not accepted will be returned with checks as soon as possible.
